**POSITION AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The District of Columbia Department of Health (DOH) seeks a Senior Deputy Director for the Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Administration (HEPRA). As a member of the executive staff of the DOH, the Senior Deputy Director is a technical authority in the in the development of Department policy, strategy, and procedure regarding acts of bioterrorism and other public health emergencies that may threaten the safety of District residents. In consultation with the Director and in accordance with established DOH objectives, the Senior Deputy Director is responsible for the prevention, assessment, and management of these emergencies. He or she supervises the mitigation of hazards and attacks as well as the investigation of causes and sources. The Senior Deputy Director serves as the principal representative of the Department to other federal, state, and local agencies, communicating with the District's Homeland Security Advisor to assure the timely flow of information regarding critical health situations, conditions, and solutions.

**REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

The successful candidate for Senior Deputy Director for the Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Administration must have at least an MS in health science, emergency health services, health management, or a related field. A PhD in a medical, health science, or allied field is preferred. The desired candidate will have at least seven (7) years of management experience in a health services area. If the candidate does not currently have at least secret clearance, he or she will be required to undergo security screening upon hire.
